

PRESUBMISSION CHECKLIST FOR MANUSCRIPTS*

Dear author,

This checklist is designed to provide you with a simple way to ensure that your manuscript is ready for submission to ESNBU. Submissions that do not comply with this checklist may be returned to authors for amendment or returned without review depending on the degree of non-compliance.

1. The submission has not been previously published, including self-published or published in a language different from English, is original and has been written by the stated authors.
2. The article is not currently being considered for publication by any other journal and will not be submitted for such review while under review by ESNBU.
3. The submission has been prepared in two separate files in Microsoft Word file format: “**TitlePage.doc(x)**” containing author details and “**BlindedDocument.doc(x)**” with no author details.
4. The submission has been made in compliance with the [Instructions for Authors](#), including length of manuscript, **ORCID IDs**, and in consideration of the [EASE Guidelines for Authors and Translators of Scientific Articles to be Published in English](#).
5. References follow the [Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 6th edition](#).
6. The text has been checked by a native speaker or a professional language editing service. Spell and grammar checks have been performed.
7. If the manuscript contains material taken from other sources it must be cited appropriately and permission given by the copyright owner if it is copyrighted.
8. All authors have read and accepted all the terms and conditions of ESNBU outlined in the Policy documentation.
9. All authors have passed the test of Authorship as defined by ESNBU.
10. All **Contributor Roles** have been agreed by all authors and contributors and assigned in accordance with the [Contributor roles in multiple author submissions](#).
11. All authors have disclosed any possible [conflicts of interest](#).
12. All Authors have read the manuscript and agree to publish it.
